Details of Costs

The Annual Subscription for Colchester Rifle Club runs concurrent with its financial year from 1 November to 31 October. The subscription rate is set each year at the AGM held in March. Subscriptions must be paid by 31 December otherwise membership of the club will be deemed lapsed. Defaulters who wish to remain members of the club will have to reapply for membership and serve as a Probationer for six months and submit a formal application as though a new member.

The Annual Range Fund Fee runs concurrently with the Annual Subscription. This was established to enable the club to purchase the Freehold of the land. The charges shown below are fixed for the foreseeable future, although should income from these fees prove inadequate to pay off our loan, they would have to be revised. The Range Fund Fee is in addition to the Annual Subscription and is mandatory. Payments for both the Annual Subscription and Range Fund Fee can be paid annually in advance, by cash or cheque or bank transfer.
